The School of Arts and Humanities is pleased to offer a number of postgraduate tuition fee bursaries for students starting one of the following postgraduate programmes in September 2011.

MLitt in Creative Writing
MLitt in English Language and Linguistics
MRes Translation Studies
LLM/MSc in Financial Services Regulation
MSc in Strategic Public Relations (Lund University)
MLitt in Film Studies

Value of the Bursaries

£1000 tuition fee awards for the MLitt/LMM/MSc and MRes programmes (available to both Home/EU and O/S students).

All bursary awards will be for one year (academic session 2011/12).

Student Eligibility

In order to be considered, you must already have been offered a place on one of our postgraduate programmes by 8 July 2011 **[Deadline has now been extended until 31 July 2011]**. **If you hold a conditional offer, you are still eligible to apply.** Applicants should not already be holding an external funding award for the 2011-12 academic session, but they may of course be in the process of applying for other awards. Applications will be ranked according to academic merit by a School awards committee. Award holders will be notified in August 2011.

How to Apply

Students applying for entry and wishing to be considered for these bursaries, should complete our Postgraduate Bursary Application Form, and submit it to arts.administrator@stir.ac.uk by 8 July 2011. **[Deadline has now been extended until 31 July 2011]**.

The Departments hope that the successful Masters applicants will wish to continue to PhD study within the School. Bursary students will be given every support in applying for external research funding, including the highly competitive AHRC Studentship scheme.

Submission Deadline

In order to be eligible, you must submit your application for admission to one of our postgraduate programmes in time for it to be fully processed, and an offer (conditional or unconditional) to be made, by 8 July 2011 **[Deadline has now been extended until 31 July 2011]**. Ideally your application for admission will have been made much earlier; certainly you should aim to complete it by early June to ensure your eligibility for the bursaries competition.

8 July 2011 is also the deadline to submit your Postgraduate Bursary Application Form to arts.administrator@stir.ac.uk at the address below. [Deadline has now been extended until 31 July 2011].
