POSTGRADUATE TUITION FEE BURSARIES

The School of Languages, Cultures and Religions is pleased to be able to offer five bursaries equivalent to the value of fees for full-time home/EU postgraduate students and one bursary equivalent to the value of fees for full-time home/EU postgraduate students and a £6000 maintenance stipend.

Programmes eligible for funding are:

- MLitt in Film Studies
- MRes in Humanities
- MLitt in Hermeneutics
- MPhil. and PhD

In order to be considered you must have already been offered a place on our postgraduate programme by 28 May 2010. **If you hold a conditional offer, you are still eligible to apply.** Applicants should not already be holding an external funding award for the 2010-11 academic session but they may of course be in the process of applying for other awards (AHRC, University Scholarships, ORSAS). Applications will be ranked according to academic merit by the Departmental Research Committee. Award holders will be notified in July 2010.

Students wishing to be considered for a bursary should mark clearly on their University application form that they wish to be considered for a tuition fee bursary.

The Departments hopes that the successful postgraduate Masters students will wish to continue to PhD study within the Department and bursary students will be given every support in applying for external research funding, including the highly competitive AHRC open studentship competition.

Submission Deadline

You must submit your application for admission to our postgraduate programme before 28 May 2010. Normally only applications which have been fully processed and students who have been offered admission on a conditional or unconditional basis by 28 May 2010 will be considered for a departmental bursary.

Bursary applications will be considered by the Departmental Research Committee.
