**ISS9GP: GREEN POLITICS: THEORY & PRACTICE

This module offers a study of green political thinking, green actors and their involvement in different political settings. The module will cover the following themes: green concepts, ideologies and approaches; state and non-state actors and their role/influence in environmental politics; comparing different political settings and their varying degrees of green policy integration.

This introductory module aims to provide you with an understanding of environmental issues and the characteristic features in environmental problem solving; illustrate the multitude of concepts, ideologies, actors and political settings involved in environmental politics; make you aware of the shared as well as setting-specific dilemmas in environmental politics and policy; evaluate the link between environmental policy intentions and reality.
