This programme will enable students to place contemporary nursing practice in Scotland within the context of a professionally informed approach to patient and healthcare.

After completion of the module the student will be able to:

- Describe and evaluate the different fields of practice within which nurses in Scotland provide care
- Discuss the nature of health care in Scotland
- Develop nursing skills in a clinical skills simulation laboratory
- Experience delivery of health care in the Scottish National Health Service
- Contrast Scottish nursing practice and philosophy with their country of origin.

Students will have the opportunity to experience one day clinical skills simulation teaching at the purpose built Skills Lab in the Centre for Health Studies building on the Highland campus in Raigmore Hospital Inverness and spend some clinical observation time in NHS resources operated by our partners in NHS Forth Valley in the Stirling region of Scotland.
