Our students rated us first in Scotland for sports facilities¹, which include a 50m swimming pool and a nine-hole golf course.

As the home of Scotland's National Swimming Academy, the Scottish National Tennis Centre and Triathlon Scotland, our campus is a formidable training ground for top Olympic and Paralympic athletes. Our student athletes regularly compete at world-class events, including the Commonwealth Games, the Olympic Games and the Walker Cup. In 2016, we welcomed our Olympic athletes home from Rio with three silver medals.
