The University of Stirling is a UK university with a global reputation for high-quality teaching and research. Our stunning 330-acre campus is based in the centre of Scotland. At Stirling, you'll enjoy access to excellent student support services, sports facilities and vibrant cultural and social scenes.

Scotland is famous for its breathtaking scenery as well as being one of the filming locations of major blockbusters including Harry Potter and James Bond Skyfall. Our campus was even one of the filming locations of the hit TV series Outlander.

The city of Stirling is an incredible mix of Scottish tradition and cosmopolitan trends – it's no surprise it's also known as 'miniature Edinburgh' (Guardian 2019).

With easy access to both Edinburgh, Scotland's capital, and Glasgow (both 40-50 minutes away by road or rail), you have the benefit of two of Scotland's largest cities nearby.

Glasgow International Airport is about 1 hour away, and Edinburgh Airport is approximately 45 minutes from our University campus – with London being only one hour's flight away. There are a range of convenient flights from China to Scotland – with four direct flights per week between Beijing and Edinburgh.

Five-star facilities

Our facilities were given five stars in the QS World University Rankings 2018, and we've even got our very own 18th-century castle. As Scotland's University for Sporting Excellence, our world-class sports facilities include the National Tennis Centre, National Swimming Academy, a nine-hole golf course and more.

We're also building for the future – which is why work is already underway on two major renovation projects that will see a combined £41 million invested in our campus and sports facilities between now and 2020.

We have more than 2,800 rooms on campus and across the city of Stirling. All accommodation is self-catered with options to suit all budgets, and prices range from £84-£172 per week.

You will have access to a dedicated 24/7 team of Accommodation Services Staff – so that students can feel safe on campus. There's also Accommodation Liaison Students who'll be around to provide support and a friendly face.

Undergraduate degrees

The Scottish undergraduate degree is usually four years in length, although entry direct to Year 2 is possible for students with a wide range of international qualifications. There are over 220 degree combinations available to students.

Undergraduate entry requirements:

Direct entry to Year 1:

- Chinese Senior Secondary School 2 Graduation Certificate with 75% overall

Applications from students who have completed their schooling in English or with an International Baccalaureate are also welcome.

Postgraduate entry requirements:

- Graduating with a minimum of 70% (65% for 211/985 institutions) in a four year Bachelor's degree.

English language requirements:

Most of our undergraduate and postgraduate courses require a minimum IELTS of 6.0. This is higher for some courses such as MBA and TESOL.

Pathway programmes

If you don't meet the required academic and English-language criteria for entry onto our degrees, we can help you prepare for academic success with our pathways to degree entry:

- **International Foundation programmes** - successful completion of this pathway offers you a direct entry to Year 2 of your chosen undergraduate degree.
- **Integrated programmes** - ideal if you want to progress to an undergraduate degree at the University of Stirling, integrated programmes can let you progress onto Year 2 or 3 of your undergraduate degree. You'll study both a university preparation programme and degree under one Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS).
- **Masters with Integrated Graduate Diploma** - a direct programme that leads to postgraduate study, providing direct entry to a Masters degree.

Pre-sessional English language courses

Our Pre-sessional English courses are ideal if you've already met the University of Stirling's academic requirements, but need to improve your English skills before starting your course.

- **12 week pre-sessional English course** (June to August) - designed to improve your IELTS score by 1.0 in one or more skills.
- **6 week pre-sessional English course** (July to August) - designed to improve your IELTS score by 0.5 in one or more skills.
- **3 week pre-sessional English course** (August) - a short course that's ideal if you already hold an unconditional offer from us, but would like to improve your English language ability.
