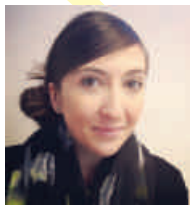
"A warm and wonderful welcome to all artists, visitors and supporters of the Forth Valley Open Studios.

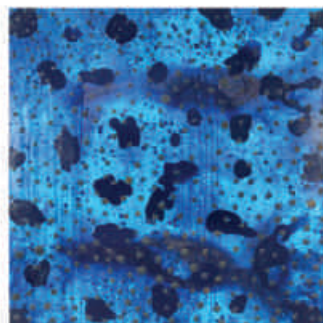
## About our Showcase Exhibition

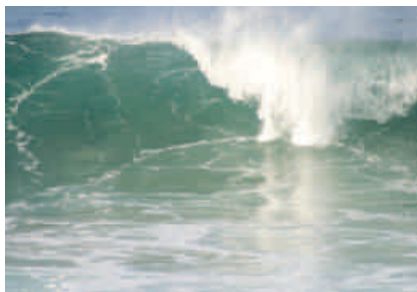
I mix powder pigments and lacquer on the canvas, add some thinners then set the canvas on FIRE. This gives a great effect, dries the painting and heats up the studio.
